4	Erasers
4	Boxes of 24-count crayons (1 box for Spanish class)
1	Pair of blunt tip scissors
1	Pencil pouch (the larger cases and pouches are better)
1	Container of disinfecting wipes (Clorox, Lysol, etc.)
1	Lunchbox (no paper bags)
2	1-subject spiral notebooks (wide-ruled, 70 sheets)
2	Jumbo glue sticks
1	Bottle of white school glue (4oz.)
1	Backpack (rolling backpacks are okay, but no Zuca backpacks)
