Language Arts

- 1) Preparing to Read: Phonics, Phonemic awareness, sounds and letters, word knowledge
- 2) Reading and Responding: Authentic literature, comprehension, inquiry and investigation, practical reading applications
- 3) Language Arts and Writing: Spelling, vocabulary, writing process strategies, writer's craft, grammar, usage & mechanics, listening, speaking & viewing, penmanship

Step Up To Writing introduces students to the language of writing. It shows students how to get actively involved with reading, how to write organized paragraphs and stories, and it provides solid sentence-writing activities at the primary level. *Step Up To Writing* is used at Resurrection School in 1st through 8th grades.

Math

In Fourth Grade we build understanding of fundamental mathematical concepts. Areas of study are basic facts and number concepts, place value, addition and subtraction, time and measurement, multiplication and division, geometry and fractions.

Social Studies

Fourth Grade social studies focuses on California. "Reflections - California - A Changing State" covers the geography of California, the first Californians, Spanish explorers and settlers (including Mission life), Mexican California, before and after the Gold Rush, California becoming a state, the Transcontinental Railroad, Agriculture, Cultures and Modern California.

The Fourth Grade science program also stresses learning through inquiry and investigation. Areas of study focus on:

- Interaction of Living Things - Plant and animal adaptations, biomes.
- The Changing Earth - Changes to earth's surface, rocks and minerals.
