Dear Families,

I thank you for your patience and support over the past few days as we deal with this dynamic situation around COVID-19. Late this afternoon I was informed by Bishop Oscar Cantú and Jennifer Beltramo that the Diocese has made the difficult decision to close all its schools to students beginning tomorrow (March 13) through March 27. Their letter is on SchoolSpeak for you to read.

Please know that, to date, no students, teachers, or parents in any of our 26 schools have tested positive for COVID-19. Nevertheless, with an abundance of caution, the Bishop and Superintendent determined that closure is necessary to protect the health and safety of all.

The faculty and staff will be on campus tomorrow to finalize our plan for Remote Distance Learning. Please note that tomorrow no students or parents will be allowed onto the school grounds. For our families who usually utilize Extended Care on in-service days, Extended Care will not be available. I will be communicating the details of our Remote Distance Learning plan with all families tomorrow.

All on-campus extracurricular activities are cancelled until further notice. This includes school sports as well as DanceMagic.

Thank you to the families who have already completed our Remote Digital Learning Preparation Survey (<http://bit.ly/ResDLPrep>). If you have not completed this survey for your family, I ask that you please do so this evening. This information will help us as we plan for remote learning during this closure.

We will be relying on SchoolSpeak to communicate with our families. Please be sure that your contact information is up to date to ensure that you receive all notifications. Additionally, you can find all our latest COVID-19 updates posted in SchoolSpeak.

The staff and I thank you for your continued support, patience, understanding, and flexibility as we walk this new and ever-changing journey together.
