5. Describe site plans to minimize COVID-19 transmission in staff breakrooms:

Currently all staff break rooms are closed. Staff will remain in stable cohorts.

6. Describe any plans to assess potential outdoor learning spaces (e.g., outdoor seating and shade/protection from elements) and/or to move instruction outdoors:

The play area is divided into 10 sections, so all stable cohorts remain 25 ft apart during recess, lunch, and breaks. All classrooms have outdoor space designated for that stable cohort to use for outdoor instruction.

7. Describe any site plans to optimize indoor ventilation (e.g., opening operable windows, using high efficiency filters, etc.):

Classrooms with two doors have both doors open at all times (air quality permitting; weather permitting), transom windows open at all times (air quality and weather permitting), and ceiling fans on up-draft mode. Filters in AC and heaters changed each trimester using MERV-13 filters.

8. Describe any plans to facilitate routine testing of teachers and staff (e.g., by healthcare providers or at County testing sites):

All faculty and staff are tested monthly.

9. Describe any plans to resume in-person instruction in phases (e.g., elementary in month 1, middle school in month 2, etc.):

We began our in-person phased in model with Kindergarten returning 10-23-20. We welcomed back TK on 10-26-20, 3rd on 10-29-20, 4th on 11-2-20, 5th on 11-9-20, 1st on 11-16-20, 6th on 11-19-20. We will welcome back 7th & 8th on 11-30-20 and 2nd on 12-8-20.

VISITORS/VOLUNTEERS

The school allows only necessary visitors and volunteers on the campus and will limit the number of students and staff who come into contact with them.

FACE COVERINGS - We will support students and staff wearing masks by:

All adults must wear a face covering at all times while on campus, except while eating or drinking. All students in transitional kindergarten through 8th grade are required to wear a face covering at all times except while eating or drinking.

PHYSICAL DISTANCING - We will support physical distancing by:

All stable cohorts will remain 6 ft apart from each other in the classroom and out on the play area. All stable cohorts will remain 25 ft apart from other stable cohorts at all times. All adults and students will remain 6 ft apart at all times.

CLEANING & MAINTENANCE

We will support cleaning and maintenance of our campus by:

Classrooms, office and all rooms are cleaned throughout the day. All desks and high touch surface areas are cleaned by faculty and staff as well as the custodians in the evening. All drinking fountains are no longer in use and shared spaces are limited.

HYGIENE - We will support routine and frequent handwashing by:

Teachers have scheduled hand washing times built into the school day. Also, students use hand sanitizer before entering the classroom as well as after recess and lunch daily.

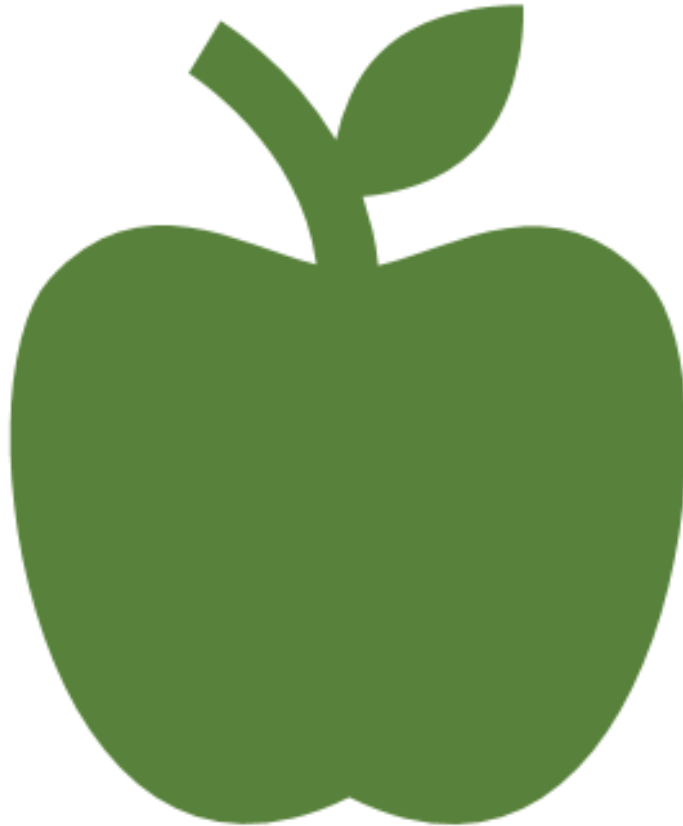
ROUTINE TESTING - We will encourage and support staff testing by:

All faculty and staff are tested once a month.
