Alumni Create Fundraising Site

In the summer of 2020, three Resurrection School alumni (Ryan Siu, Cameron Siu, and Jolie Nguyen) came together to brainstorm ways to help the school combat some of the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic. The three alumni attended Resurrection Catholic School for 10 years (JK-8). Ryan and Jolie graduated in 2015 and are now in their second year of college and Cameron graduated in 2020 and is now a freshman in high school. The trio developed a new fundraising platform named [Givelan](#). The platform's name originates from: *give* - to contribute (generously and selflessly) and *élan* - with enthusiasm. [Givelan](#) is an opportunity for donors to contribute to a diverse collection of school related projects. These projects range from purchasing COVID related supplies to improving the school track.

Since the site was launched in October 2020, the alumni team has raised a total \$7,700 with a goal of reaching \$20,000 by the end of 2021. Alumni donations fully funded the first round of COVID-19 technology and supplies. The goal of \$5,000 to improve our track is 20% away from being fully funded.
