3	Jumbo stretchy book covers OR brown bags to cover hardbound textbooks (Math, Science, Social Studies)
1	Brown bag for soft cover textbook (Religion)
1	Homework planner/notebook
1	Keyboard (Bluetooth, compatible with iPad; can be borrowed from the school)

### Items students should keep and carry in a pencil case. Please label these items. It is helpful to label individual crayons, colored pencils, and markers so that lost or misplaced items find their way back to their owners.
