1	Zippered pencil pouch (no boxes)
2	Jumbo glue sticks
1	Pair of scissors
1	Black dry erase marker
3	Composition notebooks (wide ruled)
1	Extra fine point Sharpie
1	12-inch ruler with inches and centimeters
1	Jumbo stretchy book cover OR brown bag to cover hardbound textbook (Language Arts)
1	Regular stretchy book cover to cover hardbound textbook (Language Arts)
1	Headphones or earbuds (please make sure they fit your child's ears)
